As a valued patient at one of our outlying family health clinics at Fairfax and Woodbridge, we are excited to inform you that both the clinics are relocating to expanded facilities Monday, July 2, 2012. All the healthcare services we currently provide at these facilities will continue at the new locations in Dumfries and Fairfax. Additionally, the majority of our healthcare staff is relocating to the new family health centers, ensuring continuity of care during the transition.

Our provider partner at the Dumfries and Fairfax Health Centers is Spectrum Healthcare Resources, a nationally renowned company that is exclusively dedicated to providing permanent, civilian-contracted medical professionals to military treatment facilities, Veteran Affairs clinics and other Federal agencies across the United States.

TRANSITION INFORMATION

Throughout this transition, you can simply call as normal to receive care. Our staff is always available to assist you and ensure we meet your needs. The two-phase transition of healthcare services from the existing clinics in Fairfax and Woodbridge to the new locations will begin Friday, June 22, 2012. This will be the last full day of healthcare services at the old locations.

Phase 1 (Saturday, June 23-Wednesday, June 27):

During this five-day period, we will begin relocating staff and equipment as we continue offering Acute Care and Pre-natal services (only) at the existing locations. Pharmacy and laboratory services will be available, although some lab tests may be sent to Fort Belvoir Community Hospital for processing. Radiology services will not be available during this period. Wednesday, June 27, will be the last day of services in the old family health centers. As always, you can seek emergency care at Fort Belvoir Community Hospital or the nearest local emergency room.

Phase 2 (Thursday, June 28-Saturday, June 30):

During this three-day period, the existing clinics will completely close to enable the final movement of staff and equipment to the new locations. Dedicated staff will be available to assist with your acute care needs at the Family Medicine Clinic, Fort Belvoir Community Hospital (9300 Dewitt Loop, Fort Belvoir, VA 22060).
