### Chief of Staff

U.S. Navy Captain Bigby currently serves as Chief of Staff at Fort Belvoir Community Hospital. Belvoir Hospital is a 120-bed, 1.3 million-square-foot military community hospital that serves a regional population of 250,000 beneficiaries with over 92,000 enrollees receiving inpatient and specialty care services supported by 55 specialty clinics, a Warrior Pavilion (for combat injured/wounded/ill), Inpatient Addictions Program, and two satellite family health centers at Dumfries and Fairfax, Va.

Prior to assuming his current position, Capt. Bigby was the Director for Administration at Fort Belvoir Community Hospital. As the Director for Administration, Capt. Bigby was the officer in charge of the directorate and provided administrative support to the command. In addition, he provided direction and support to the other Belvoir Hospital directorates and set policy to ensure a coordinated effort in support of the hospital's mission requirements.
